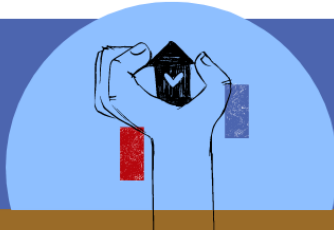

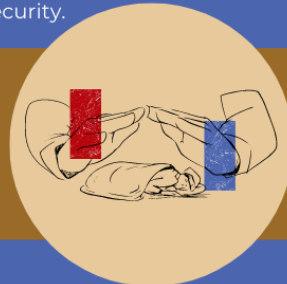
1 Affordable Housing

Addressing the pipelines to homelessness, increasing prevention strategies, and providing additional resources including wraparound services and case management will help the most at-risk individuals in our community.



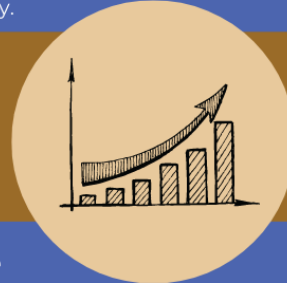
3 Public Safety
